The Chair, Chuck Smithwick, called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. The roll was called and there were 10 of 19 members present representing the LNBA and 12 of 24 members present representing the NRCA. There was a quorum present for both associations and guests were introduced and recognized.

Board Minutes – The Board Minutes for the May 2, 2024 meeting were presented. Being no revisions, Dan Wall made the motion to approve, seconded by David Suggs, and approved by the Boards.

LNBA/NRCA Financials – *Treasurer's Report* – Jimmy Pridgen presented the Treasurer's Report for the period of May, June, July, and August, 2024 to the Board. As of August 31st, the LNBA account balance is \$286,911.37 and NRCA account balance is \$364,363.06. Also available for the Board's review were the year-to-date expenditures (for both associations) for FY 2023-24. Following discussion, Jonathon Bulla made the motion to approve the reports as presented, seconded by David Suggs, and approved by the Boards, respectively.

990 Tax Return for 2023 – Haywood reported the 2023 990 Tax Return (for the LNBA and NRCA) has been completed and emailed to the Board member for their review. Haywood asked if anyone had any questions or comments to please let him know as soon as possible because the reports will be submitted to the IRS around October 1, 2024.

LNBA and NRCA Bylaw Revisions for Consideration – Dan McLawhorn, counsel to the Boards, and Haywood reported to the Boards that the recent officer changes due to retirement and resignations has caused a need to review the associations' bylaws and consider revisions that will allow replacing of those officers less challenging. The bylaws currently do not permit replacing of an officer unless it's at the designated annual meeting. In late 2023, the Chair retired (November) as well as the Treasurer (December) thus leaving a void. The annual meeting was designated in February, 2024 and new officers were elected. In July the Secretary resigned leaving another vacancy. Dan reviewed the revisions for considered noting that this was information and the proposed revisions will be an agenda item on the

NRCA Midyear Draft Report for 2023 – Haywood reported the NRCA midyear draft report has been completed and asked all members to review their data for accuracy. The members delivered 2.50 mg/L of total nitrogen to Neuse estuary from July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024. Haywood reminded the NRCA Board member the midyear report is used to calculate the NRCA membership dues. Also included in the agenda package was an updated graph of total nitrogen loading at Fort Barnwell, monitoring station J7850000, from 1995 thru 2022.

Annual Training Workshop Committee – Haywood reported that there were 38 attendees that received a CEU certificate at the Raleigh training workshop and 29 attendees received CEU certificates at the Kinston workshop. The cost for the meals for both locations was \$1,859.70. The CEU report was emailed to the Certification office on August 12, 2024.

LNBA/NRCA Delegates – Haywood reminded the membership to please keep the membership delegates updated by notifying him.

The next meeting is scheduled for November 7, 2024 at 10:00 hosted by the City of Kinston. With no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

Work continues on the Lower Neuse River Monitoring Service Contract No. 6 with Waypoint Analytical. All sampling was completed by Waypoint in September and October with the exceptions listed below:

September 2024

09/04/24 – J4580000 (Swift Creek at SR 1152) near Smithfield - Unable to collect due to access being blocked. Resampled on September 17, 2024.

J5007000 (Middle Creek at SR 1504 (Crantock Road) near Coats Crossroads – Temporary sampling site for J5010000 (Middle Creek at NC 210 near Smithfield) while bridge is replaced.

October 2024

10/17/24 – J4690000 (Middle Creek at SR 1152 near Holly Springs) – Unable to sample due to bridge construction. 10/15/24 – J6250000 (Neuse River at NC 55 near Graingers) – Closed due to new construction.

All invoices have been processed and paid through September.
